## Top 50 MicroStation Commands

- 1. ACCUDRAW Opens the AccuDraw dialog box to aid in precision drawing.
- 2. ALIGN Aligns two or more elements with respect to a reference point.
- 3. ANNOTATE Opens the text editor to create, edit or modify text.
- 4. ARC Creates an arc element.
- 5. ARRAY Creates a rectangular or polar array of elements.
- 6. ATTACH Attaches a reference file to the current file.
- 7. BACKGROUND Sets the background color of the view window.
- 8. BOUNDARY Creates a closed element from a series of connected elements.
- 9. CELL Inserts a cell (a group of elements) into the drawing.
- 10. CHAMFER Creates a chamfer between two straight lines.
- 11. CHANGE LEVEL Changes the level of selected elements.
- 12. CIRCLE Creates a circle element.
- 13. CLIP Clips an element to a boundary element or view window.
- 14. COLOR Sets the color of selected elements.
- 15. COPY Copies selected elements.
- 16. CUT Cuts selected elements.
- 17. DELETE Deletes selected elements.
- 18. DIMENSION Creates a dimension element.
- 19. DIVIDE Divides a line or curve into equal segments.
- 20. ELLIPSE Creates an ellipse element.
- 21. ENDPOINT Snaps to the endpoint of a line or curve.
- 22. EXTRACT Extracts a portion of an element into a new element.
- 23. FENCE Selects elements inside a fence boundary.
- 24. FILLET Creates a rounded corner between two lines or curves.
- 25. HIDE Hides selected elements.
- 26. LEVEL Creates a new level or modifies an existing one.
- 27. LINE Creates a line element.
- 28. MATCH Matches the properties of selected elements to a reference element.
- 29. MEASURE Measures the distance and angle between two points.
- 30. MERGE Merges two or more elements into a single element.
- 31. MIRROR Mirrors selected elements.
- 32. MOVE Moves selected elements.
- 33. OFFSET Creates a parallel line or curve offset from a reference line or curve.
- 34. ORTHO Restricts cursor movement to the horizontal and vertical axes.
- 35. PLACE NOTE Places a note on the drawing.
- 36. POINT Creates a point element.
- 37. POLYGON Creates a polygon element.
- 38. PRINT Prints the drawing to a printer or plotter.
- 39. PROPERTIES Displays or modifies the properties of selected elements.
- 40. PULL Extrudes a 2D element to create a 3D solid.
- 41. REDO Redoes the previous undo operation.
- 42. REFEDIT Edits a reference file directly in the current file.

- 43. ROTATE Rotates selected elements around a reference point.
- 44. SCALE Scales selected elements.
- 45. SELECT Selects elements for modification or manipulation.
- 46. SNAP Snaps the cursor to a specified distance or angle.
- 47. SPLINE Creates a spline element.
- 48. TEXT Creates a text element.
- 49. UNDO Undoes the previous operation.
- 50. VIEW Sets or modifies the view window parameters.
